The Arts of Kenmore (AOK) is seeking **original** artwork from youth artists: only 5-18 year olds are eligible for this exhibit. The Theme is open to any medium resulting in 2-Dimensional, traditional or non-traditional work. Artists may submit up to two works. Approximately 30 pieces will be selected for display. Youth entrants are encouraged, but not required, to price works for sale. The Arts of Kenmore will receive a 30% on all sales.

Entries will be accepted, juried, and awarded, in the following age group categories:

5-8 years old, 9-12 years old, 13-15 years old, 16-18 years old

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Awards presented in each age group category.
Recognition Certificates presented to all selected artists.

Entry Procedure:

Fill out the **Artists Registration** form available by clicking [here] or on our website at www.artsofkenmore.org/events/call-to-youth-artists/.

- Provide a JPEG image of your artwork(s) only. *Do not show frame nor frame size indication!*
- JPEG **must** be titled as follows: Title_Medium_Dimensions (Height x Width in inches). Example:
SummerDays_oilpastel_18x20

Entry Requirements:

Entrants must warrant that all submitted artwork is original. Works cannot be based on previously published work, cannot infringe the copyright or trademark of any third party or any laws (no Disney), and must be executed with the permission of the subject. Prints and reproductions are disqualified, except on Digital works. Student artwork produced under the supervision of an instructor is acceptable. Entries must not have been shown at a prior AOK Gallery exhibit. Maximum framed size H60" x W36"

Entry Fee:

There is no entry fee for youth (5-18 yo). Youth entrants and/or families are encouraged, but not required, to become an AOK Supporters at www.artsofkenmore.org/aok-heroes/. Your support is much appreciated!

Selection Process:

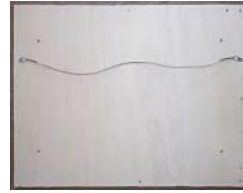
The Jury Panel consists of representatives from the Arts of Kenmore and the Gallery Curator. Selected artwork will be judged on composition, artistry, technique, skill, and originality. The jurors reserve the discretion to decline artwork containing explicit content. Approximately 30 pieces will be selected for display.

Due Dates

October 22 – Submissions Due by Midnight

October 29 – Jury Selection notification. Artists will be notified by email of juried results.

- Artwork must be wired with D-Rings across the back for hanging. No exposed glass edges, clip frames, or saw-tooth hanging devices will be accepted. *NO EXCEPTIONS!*
- Maximum framed size H60" x W36"



November 5 – Submit the following to Sara Hayashi at art4ussh@aol.com

- **Artist's Indemnity Waiver & Release form.** Must be Signed by parent or guardian of youth 5-17. Print, fill-in, scan and return via email. Must include title, medium(s), size (Height" x Width"), and price.
- **Artist's bio**/statement
- **Headshot** photograph or Selfie is acceptable.

November 14 – Art In-take at 1-2pm: All selected entries must be hand-delivered *

- *Volunteers needed 2-5pm!* Volunteer hours honored for NHS, IB, GSA & BSA – bring form for signature!
- Entries must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit.

November 16 – Opening Reception at 6:30-8pm, 7pm awards presentation!

January 23, 2018 at 4-5pm – Exhibit Take-down: All unsold artwork must be picked up between 4-5pm*

- Artwork not picked up within 90 days becomes property of the Arts of Kenmore organization.*

* AOK Gallery does not manage operations at Kenmore City Hall. Onsite storage is not available. If you are unable to deliver or pick-up artwork at designated times you are encouraged to make arrangements with fellow artists or family, or contact the curator immediately. Artwork not picked up within 90 days becomes property of AOK.

Liability

The City of Kenmore and the Arts of Kenmore are held harmless to any and all liability per the Artist's Indemnity Waiver & Release form. The AOK Gallery management will take reasonable precautions to prevent loss or damage to artworks, but the entrant must assume liability.

Arts of Kenmore and Gallery Information:

The Arts of Kenmore, a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization, partners with the City of Kenmore to produce four to five exhibits annually. The AOK Gallery is a building design feature at Kenmore City Hall that promotes the city's goal of providing a free venue to showcase the works of local artists.

The AOK mission is to encourage and promote both active & passive participation in all forms of the arts by the citizens of the area for the enrichment of the community. AOK produces the Kenmore Art Show, public art projects, and community & municipal collaborations. All revenue supports grants for arts education in local public schools.
